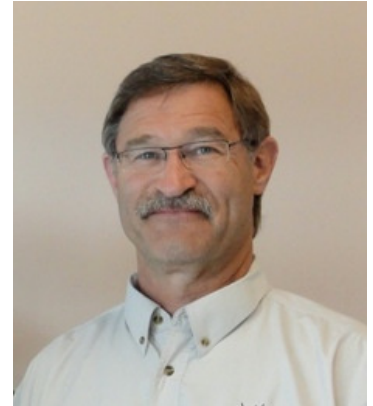
A Message from the

President of the Board and the CEO



These are challenging times. There are no easy decisions and no easy answers. The economic recession continues to challenge our families, the people we serve, and this organization. And while other organizations have responded by shrinking, cutting services, or shutting their doors, Genesis

Development has responded by strengthening its operations, expanding its services to new communities, and working to support its mission of creating opportunities, choices and support for people with disabilities. Here are four of our major challenges and how we are working to address them:



- 1. Meeting the increasingly complex needs of people with disabilities. The opening of a new Discovery program in Winterset is an example of how we are working closely with a county in trying to meet the needs of people with disabilities. A day program provided by another agency there closed and we were asked by the county to consider developing a program that might meet their needs.*
- 2. Reduced demand for our business activities. The economic recession has caused a reduction in demand for goods and services for businesses across the state. Genesis Development's business activities are no exception. When others chose to close operations, we instead chose to make our operations more efficient and make strategic investments in our business operations. For example, when our laundry orders increased, we purchased new equipment to increase our laundry capacity. We can now handle more customers and provide more opportunities for the people we serve. We also upgraded the box-making equipment to make our box operation more efficient. The change will help our staff become more efficient and provide better products to our corrugated customers.*
- 3. Requests for Genesis to fix failing operations. The economic recession, dwindling funding, and the increasing complexity of serving people with disabilities has hit hard across the state. Rather than struggling through difficulties, some organizations close. Genesis Development has developed a reputation for its ability to step into these situations and provide services when other organizations fail. We see this as providing an important service that fulfills our mission.*
- 4. Heavy reliance on federal and state funds. This continues to be one of the greatest challenges for Genesis. It is a fact that most of the people we serve rely on the government for support. And when the government does not live up to its commitment to our people, they suffer and we are challenged with finding ways to continue serving them with less funding. Where possible, we have worked to reshape our services so they can continue. We have also found a way to expand popular and effective programs like our Discovery Program that provide fun and meaningful experiences for our consumers.*

We are confident that Genesis Development will survive through these challenging times, and we will thrive well into the future. We are confident because we are committed to our mission, we have great staff that work hard and believe in what they do, and our staff, volunteers and contributors care deeply about the people that we serve.

FY2011 Highlights

Genesis received its tenth consecutive 3-year CARF award, the highest accreditation award given. Peer surveyors from around the country conducted a rigorous accreditation process in which services, programs, business practices, policies, safety procedures, governance, medication monitoring, accessibility, community integration, housing and a host of other factors at all sites were scrutinized and observed to determine if all standards were being met.



In the fall of 2010, the Buena Vista County Landfill discontinued dealing with can and bottle reclamation and redemption creating a much greater demand for Genesis redemption services in Storm Lake. The volume of cans and bottles almost doubled after the landfill's closing which led to the purchase of some new equipment and created more work opportunities for those in the vocational program.

Three more group-living homes were opened in Indianola this fiscal year bringing the total to five in that community.

The newest Genesis site in Toledo has been providing residential services at Pheasant Ridge since 2009. This fiscal year, Genesis began providing Supported Community Living Services for people living in their own homes in Tama County.



At the request of case managers and parents, Genesis in Boone began offering Explorers, a summer day camp for school aged children with disabilities. Explorers provides a safe, structured program during the months that the students are not in school based programs.

Genesis in Jefferson began providing another work opportunity for those in the Work Services program with a new custodial contract with the Perry Health Care Center. A rotating work crew handles all of the cleaning duties at the care center Monday through Friday. Other new custodial contracts included Jefferson City Hall and the City Maintenance building. The Boone Custodial crew received a certificate of achievement from NISH for outstanding performance of its Ability One Program contract at Camp Dodge.

Growth of the Discovery Program in Boone necessitated remodeling and expanding into the next section of the building in which Genesis is located. More than 80 individuals are participating in that Discovery program with 17 full-time and part-time staff. About a third of those are one-on-one staff who enable individuals with severe disabilities to take part in daily Discovery activities.



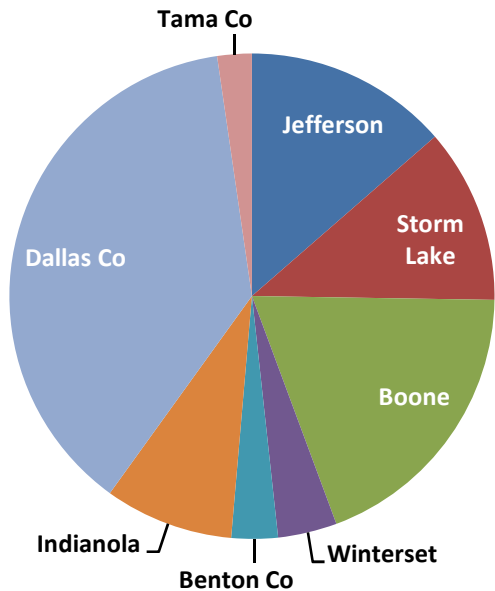
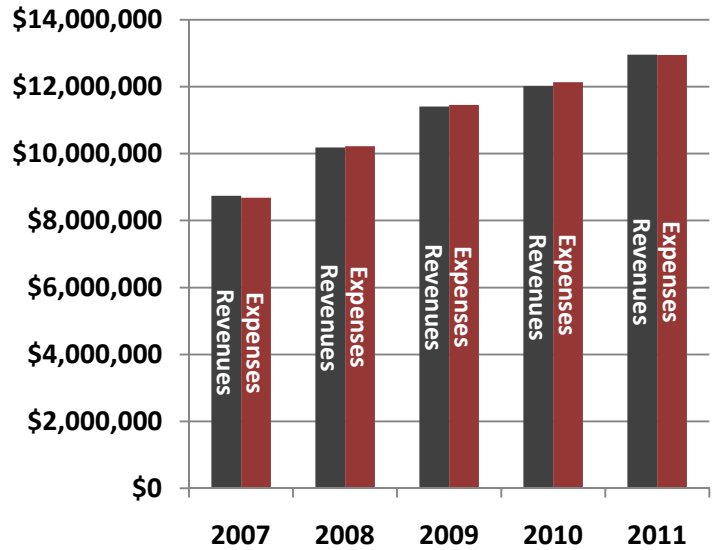
Genesis Textile Services in Indianola continued to grow with the addition of seven Signature Health Care Center LLC Group nursing homes added to the list of laundry customers. These new contracts required expanded hours of operation, the addition of another delivery route, and created work opportunities for more of the people that we serve.

Genesis began a concentrated effort to raise funds to transition the entire agency to electronic documentation capabilities. The transition will assure that Genesis meets Federal and State funder's requests for documentation that is accessible on-line to agencies that monitor service providers. Electronic storage of documentation will also solve the growing problem of confidential storage of paper documentation that's done daily for each person receiving services, make the documentation process much more efficient for staff, and decrease overtime expenses.

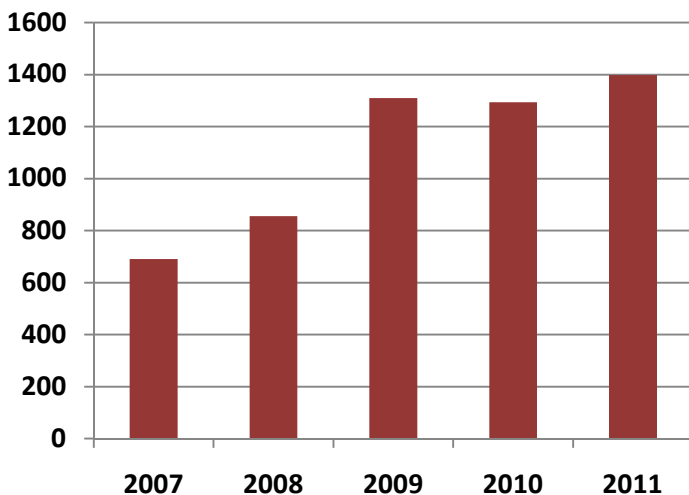
Five-year Financial Growth



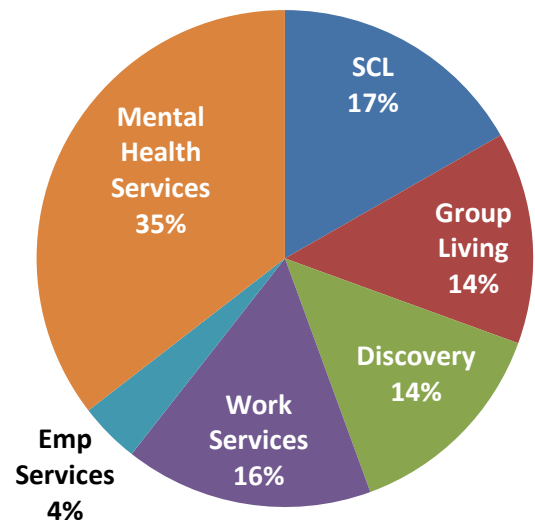
