Genesis Earns 10th CARF Accreditation

Every three years for the past thirty years Genesis has undergone a rigorous accreditation process in which services, programs, business practices, policies, safety procedures, governance, medication monitoring, accessibility, community integration, housing and a host of other factors at all of our nine sites are reviewed by CARF – the international Commission on Accreditation for Rehabilitation Facilities.



This survey took place in October as a group of five CARF surveyors from Minnesota, Missouri, Massachusetts, Georgia and Wyoming went over mountains of paperwork and documentation, conducted interviews with individuals receiving services, case managers, family members, staff and board members and toured many of the facilities and production areas all in an effort to determine the caliber and quality of services provided by Genesis Development. The result was a Three-Year Award, the highest obtainable and the tenth consecutive Three-Year CARF Award for Genesis. The 46 page final report was prefaced by 32 specific strengths that were exhibited in various areas including comments like the following:

- Staff members are knowledgeable, compassionate and caring. They also advocate for the persons served by seeking ways to accommodate any special needs. The staff sees the potential of all the persons served and assists them to live at their highest possible level of functioning.
- The organizational structure of Genesis Development demonstrates services where the borders of individual employee’s responsibilities and job descriptions are blurred in a team effort to best support the persons served. Regardless of position, employees demonstrated a genuine kinship for each other and the persons they served.
- Persons served by Genesis Development consistently expressed satisfaction with the services provided and stated that their specific needs are being met.
- Perry’s (Mental Health) play therapy is commended for its extensive and therapeutic environment.
- The Discovery program provides creative and very flexible activities in an environment that very much communicates respect and appreciation for individual differences. Staff members have made many wonderful community connections, such as in Boone where the mayor frequently initiates shared activities to promote civic initiatives.
- Plans provide very clear, measureable and individualized objectives. This seemed quite consistent within the organization and shows the benefit of a focused training effort.

CARF is an independent, nonprofit accrediting body whose mission is to promote the quality, value, and optimal outcomes of services through a consultative accreditation process that centers on enhancing the lives of the persons served. Donations Aid Redemption Expansion

Early this fall, the Buena Vista County Landfill made the decision to turn their site into a “transfer” station rather than sorting and storing products. This meant they would no longer be dealing with can and bottle reclamation and redemption. About a year ago the Landfill purchased a \$15,000 can counter with a grant from the DNR. The counter is capable of counting both cans and half liter beverage containers at the same time with one to two people operating it. Last year the Genesis

Redemption Center handled 4.3 million cans and bottles without a can counter. It’s estimated that at least another 2 million will now come to Genesis that formerly went to the Landfill. A can counter almost becomes a necessity to handle the increased product. With a \$5,000 price tag to purchase the Landfill’s counter, a fundraising campaign was initiated and very quickly proved successful. Within a very short time, six generous donors made the purchase possible. More than half of the funds needed were provided by the Storm Lake chapter of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows. Other donors included MetaBank, Central Bank, Security Trust & Savings Bank, Merrill Manufacturing, Michael and Joann Westphal, and Reyes Hearing Aid Center – Fred Reyes.

Genesis Gives Back

Eagle Scout Project Benefits Genesis



Sam Williams, son of a Genesis staff member in Storm Lake, has spent the past two summers working in the Genesis Redemption Department, so he knows Genesis well. When it was time for him to decide on a project to achieve Eagle Scout status, he chose to construct a sidewalk from the Genesis building to the Gazebo behind the building. He stated his reason for the choice was because “when it rains the gazebo is inaccessible for physically handicapped consumers until the ground dries. Working with them, I thought that it was unfair for them that most other consumers could access something they couldn’t. The sidewalk path allows them to access the gazebo even on days that it has rained.” With six other scouts and four adults they created the concrete path that’s very much appreciated by everyone.

Adel Church Donation

When our newest Genesis office in Adel was being developed, a grant application was submitted to help with the expenses involved with that process. The grant was unsuccessful, but a local church came to the rescue. One of the primary needs for that office was partitions to allow for multiple staff members to share the one-room office space. Employment Services staff member, Deb Hansen, searched Craig’s List for the needed partitions and found that Grace Lutheran Church in Adel had just what was needed for sale. After visiting with the church about what Genesis does for people with disabilities, Grace Lutheran donated the partitions at no cost. This church is committed to supporting community projects and Genesis is very grateful to Grace Lutheran and Pastor Bernau for the support they have given to our staff in Adel.

The group still painted tables and collected pop cans, but funds earned could be used for additional activities.
